After almost a decade of history, the Costa Rica International Film Festival (CRFIC) is testimony to the inescapable commitment of the Costa Rican Film Production Center (CCPC) —a center of the Ministry of Culture and Youth (MCJ)— to the right to manifest difference with dignity; the right of artists, creators and workers to produce film; the right of the population to enjoy the cinematographic experience regardless of economic, political, social, cultural or territorial distinctions.

After nine years of life, the CRFIC reaffirms itself as an independent film festival with a respectfully radical vocation for the cinematographic and audiovisual diversity with which each person exercises the right to an identity and a unique creative voice, expressed with stylistic and thematic freedom.

Hybrid proposals, polyphonic authorial narratives, genres without borders, beauty without stereotypes, with









diffuse and open limits: the festival is committed to everything that displays the complexities of life itself.

## CRFIC9 CATEGORIES



CENTRAL AMERICAN \_\_\_\_\_AND CARIBBEAN FEATURE \_\_ FILM \_\_\_\_COMPETITION \_\_\_\_

The Central American and Caribbean Feature Film Competition is a competitive section that showcases regional cinema in its different facets and modes of representation, and serves as a platform to distinguish diverse sensibilities and ways of telling stories. Behind its plurality lies the seal of Central America and the Caribbean as a region whose filmmakers share stories, concerns and identities.

NATIONAL \_\_\_\_\_ SHORT FILM COMPETITION \_\_\_\_\_

The National Short Film Competition is a section made up of Costa Rican short films, which aims to highlight the value of short stories as a cinematographic modality of inherent artistic potential and constant creative inquiry; it also provides a platform for new voices in filmmaking.

## PANORAMA

The Panorama section brings together the most recent works of filmmakers who have become benchmarks of independent cinema worldwide, either because of the masterful way in which they revisit recurring themes in their filmography, or because they are continually reinventing themselves.



This section brings together films that are unafraid to distance themselves from the usual canons associated with cinema as a language, along with works by filmmakers who, even at an early stage of their careers, show a particular talent for building fascinating characters, shaping stories of surprising lucidity or delving into unusual forms of storytelling.

## ENFOQUE

This section shows a series of recent short films sharing a theme, a technique, an aesthetic inquiry or the criteria of a guest curator. Its purpose is to show new expressive paths and to exhibit different ways of understanding contemporary cinema.

This section shows films which are relevant due to their topicality, innovation or connection with the region, whether in feature, medium-length or short film format. The works here showcased stand out because of their making, their subject matter or the debates they stimulate; they are placed in dialogue with the other sections without being tied to their approaches.

## 'LTI MA TANDA TANDA

In addition to being open to stylistic hybridization, this section offers narrative genres which are evocative of the night, given their tone or their ability to elicit tension and suspense: action, horror, zombie, thriller, fantasy or science fiction films.



### RETROS\_ PEC TIVA\_

The Retrospectiva section is dedicated to a living filmmaker of international renown whose work demonstrates a commitment to cinematic exploration in different formats, genres, themes and forms of production.


## MUESTRA DE CORTOS INSTITUTO \_\_\_\_\_ MEXICANO DE CINEMATOGRAFÍA

# AWARDS FOR FILMS IN COMPETITION

In addition to the CRFIC statuette, the ninth edition of the Festival will award 7 million colones (US\$11K) in incentives and support to filmmakers in its competitive categories: a prize of 1 million colones to the Best national short film, a prize of 3 million colones to the Best Costa Rican feature film, and a prize of 3 million colones to the Best feature film from Central America and the Caribbean.



### INDUSTRIA AWARDS

The awards for the winners of the Project Presentation Forum consist of a 2.5 million colones prize to finance the development or production stage of a film, as well as the Cine House Award, which consists of a loan of complete camera equipment and lighting truck, sponsored by Cine House, one of the largest equipment rental companies in Costa Rica and Panama.

The awards for Films in Post-production are distributed in a prize of 2.5 million colones to finance the post-production stage of a Costa Rican film; another prize of 2.5 million colones to finance the post-production stage of a film, open to all participants from Central America; and Say the SAME Subtitles Award for translation and subtitling in two languages, sponsored by the Mexican company Say the SAME, a leader in audiovisual translation and subtitling for film festivals.












## HEALTH PROTOCOLS DURING THE CRFIC FOR THE PUBLIC \_\_\_\_\_



#### **TEMPERATURE:**


